Good morning! Yes. The testing is not covered. If the determination is made that work needs to be done and a contract in excess of \$2,000 proceeds, a prevailing wage rate is required to be utilized in the bidding process and in the signed contract. The scope of work would determine which rate is applicable, either HUD determined for non-routine maintenance or Davis-Bacon for work deemed development.

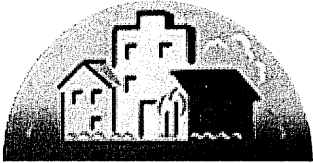
Can you please confirm this for me.
